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Walking offers a very good option to replace short car trips, providing health benefits as well as being the most sustainable mode of travel. Walking also has the benefit of guaranteed travel times, with no delays for congestion.

Within Pilning and Severn Beach itself lie some shops and services, including Morrisons Daily, Pilning Convenience Store. The footways within Pilning and Severn Beach are lit, and are well maintained. There are multiple informal crossing facilities and formal crossing facilities at junctions.

Staff living within a reasonable distance of PMG Services have the option to walk to/from work. Some may choose to walk a longer distance to gain the health benefits or savings in travel costs.

For those wishing to walk with others, [Join My Journey](#) puts people who travel the same route in touch with each other. PMG Services will register with the hub to match colleagues.

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Cycling is another way to avoid traffic jams, keep fit and save on travel. National Cycle Routes (NCR) 4 and 41 pass through Severn Beach and the connection from PMG Services is via Church Road and Little Green Lane.

NCR 4 north provides links to South Wales and south provides links to Avonmouth, Cribbs Causeway, and Bristol City Centre.

NCR 41 north provides links to Thornbury via the Avon Cycleway and south provides links through Avonmouth and onwards to Lawrence Weston, the Avon Gorge, and Bristol City Centre.

Route planning is available via [Better by Bike](#) which gives options for fastest, quietest and balanced routes as well as information on hills.

For those who want to give cycling a try, loan bikes are available from [Better by Bike](#) with a deposit. Loaned bikes include locks and lights.

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Public Transport can be cheaper, quicker and more convenient sometimes than using a car. What is more, it significantly benefits the environment and can provide the passenger with a more relaxed journey.

Bus stops are located on the B4064 Redwick Road and Severn Beach Station and are serviced the Stagecoach route 12 which operates between Severn Beach and Bristol Parkway via Cribbs Causeway and Patchway.

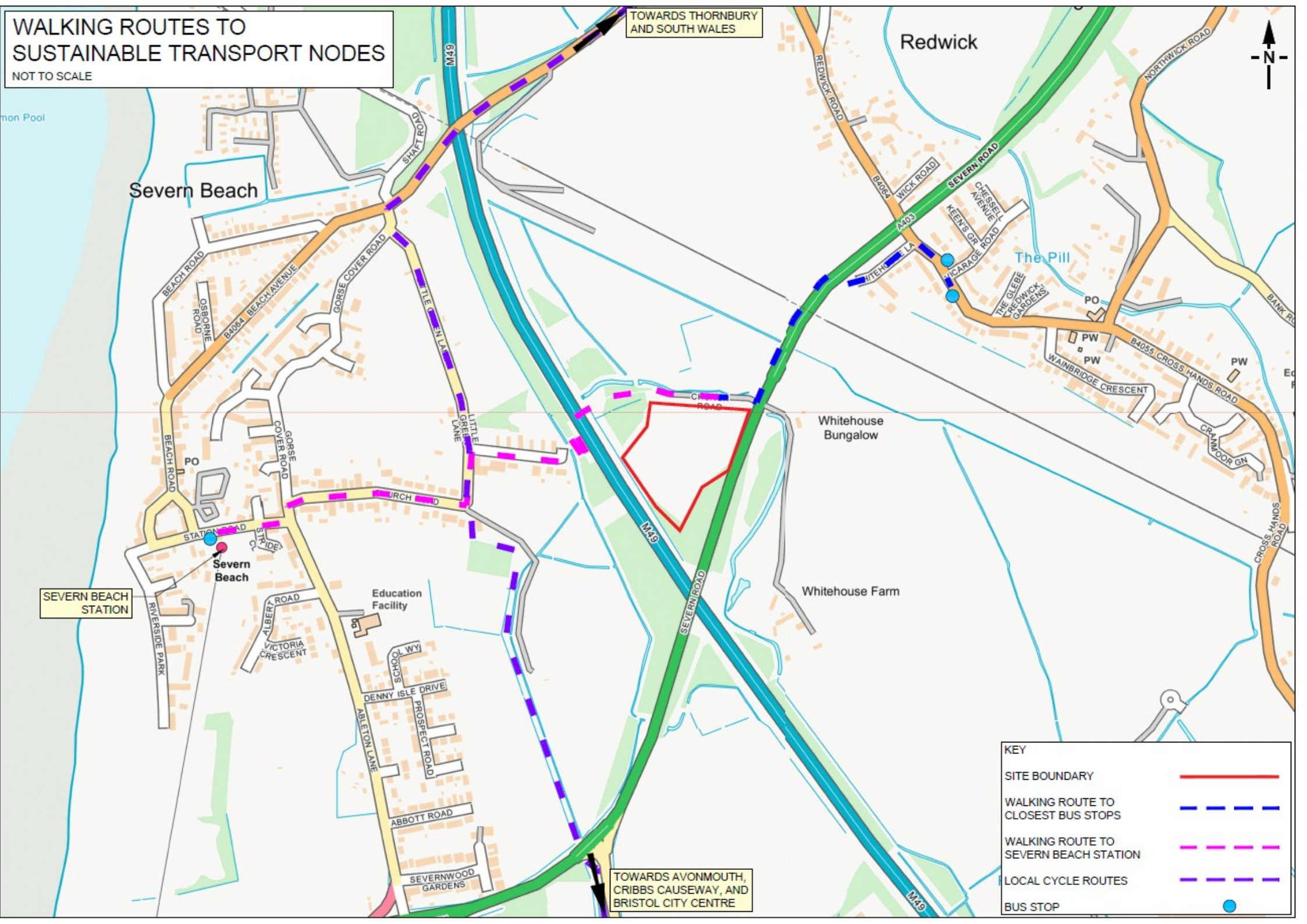


WALKING ROUTES TO SUSTAINABLE TRANSPORT NODES
